About Marc Murray (FRCO, DipChD)

Marc Murray was born and educated in Cape Town, South Africa with initial studies at the University of Cape Town's College of Music. In 2010, Marc moved to the United Kingdom to take up the post of Director of Music at St Botolph's Church (Boston Stump, Lincolnshire). As an organist, he has given recitals and played in concerts throughout South Africa, as well as the USA, Germany, Sweden, and the UK, including solo recitals in Westminster Abbey, St Paul's, Southwark, Blackburn, Chester, Newcastle and Bradford Cathedrals.

Marc is also Director of Music and Master of the Choir School of St Mary the Virgin, Bury Parish Church, and between 2017 and 2019, was Conductor of Chester St. Cecilia Singers, having previously been their accompanist since 2015. In September 2019, he became conductor of the Rawsthorne Singers, and in 2022, Preston Cecilian Choral Society.

At present Marc is PhD Student at the University of York researching the music of Thomas Dupuis within 'The Land without music'.
